

GENERAL INFORMATION



To help you park easily and safely in Rugby, the Council has a number of car parks in the town which are divided into short and long stay car parks.



The Council operates a 'pay and display' system. Tickets are purchased from meters which accept 5p, 10p, 20p, 50p, £1 & £2 coins, with the exception of the John Barford Multi-Storey where machines will not accept £2 coins. No Change given.



Charges for most vehicles operate between 8.00am and 6.00pm on Monday to Saturdays. Large vehicles (over 3 tonnes unladen) operate for the full 24 hours— Monday to Saturday.



There is no charge for people clearly displaying a valid blue disabled person badges.

SEASON TICKETS



It is possible to purchase a season ticket on a quarterly and monthly basis. Season tickets are only available for Long Stay Car Parks.

OVERNIGHT PARKING



If you wish to park overnight please purchase a ticket on arrival to cover the chargeable hours the vehicle will be parked. (see charges board). Unused credit from one day will be transferred to the next day at the start of the charging period.



To ensure that the car parks are operated efficiently Parking Attendants regularly patrol the car parks.

PENALTY CHARGE

Penalty charges are imposed if you:

- Fail to display a valid ticket/valid blue badge
- Overstay the parking time purchased
- Park outside marked spaces
- Park in a reserved space

SECURITY

The town centre closed circuit television system enables operators to view Chestnut Field, Little Church Street, North Street, Railway Terrace, the John Barford Multi-Storey Car Parks and the on street parking.

The car parks and on street parking are patrolled on a regular basis to help provide a safer environment for the customer.



Every year thousands of pounds worth of property is stolen from cars left unattended in car parks. Please help the Police and yourself by reducing the risk of it happening to you. Please help by taking the following precautions.

DO'S & DON'TS

- Never leave your Sat Nav in your vehicle.
- Always close all windows and lock all doors.
- Never leave valuables on view – lock them in the boot.
- If you leave your vehicle in the street or in a car park overnight, choose a well-lit spot.
- Fit a security device to the hi-fi and radio.
- Invest in a locking petrol cap and ensure that alloy wheels are protected with locking nuts.
- Never leave your vehicle documents in the car – if you do it's easier for the thief to dispose of the vehicle.
- Don't leave keys in the car.
- After parking, always check that the steering lock has engaged. Better still install an alarm with an ignition immobiliser.

Monthly season tickets are payable by direct debit for a minimum period of one year available at £70 per month. Commencing 1st of each month.
